AV-36 construction & flight, flying at Cook's field and at Wenatchee and Regina.

These are classics. The construction of the Fauvel AV-36 flying wing glider by members of the RCAF Tenardee club in Calgary in the early 50s and the activities in southern Alberta that led to the discovery of the mountain wave and the establishment of Cowley as a soaring centre. Edited from old home movies taken by AW (Bill) Riddell, one of the AV-36 builders and Tenardee founder, and he did the voice-over on the video.
